GARDEN

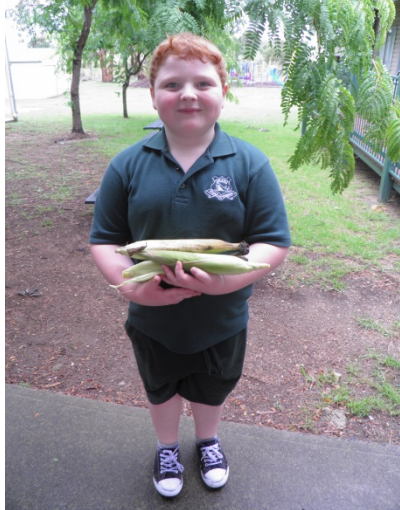
When we got back to school yesterday, we were amazed to find that our gardens had grown huge.
