Morning tea will be served after the planting. We look forward to seeing you all here.

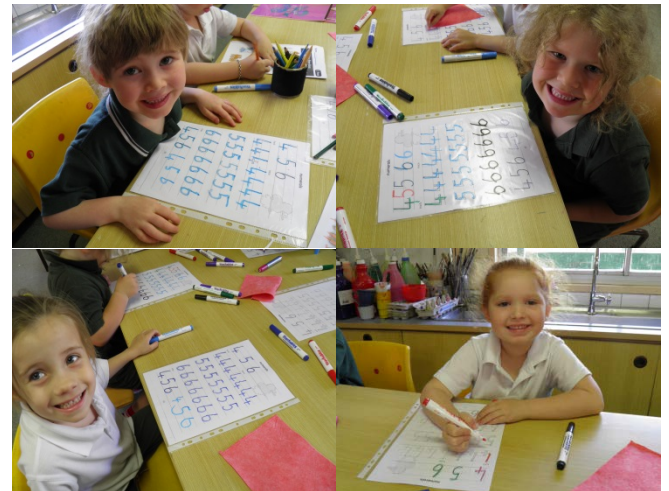
P&C MEETING
