BEACH TO BUSH

We were lucky enough to have a visit from three surf life savers Andy, Danny and Ang on Thursday. The Beach to Bush Program was designed to teach people in regional, rural and remote areas about surf and water safety. The lifesavers shared important knowledge and stories that can help keep us safe at the beach; including how to read safety signs, recognising hazards, how to spot a rip current, dangerous marine animals, and the importance of surf lifesavers. The program was very hands on and students enjoyed the program immensely and showed a high level of involvement. The acronym learnt for when we go to the beach using the letters FLAGS, was Find the flags, Look for safety, Ask a lifesaver or lifeguard for advice, Go swimming with an adult and Signal for help when in trouble.
