Happy Birthday Tesha! We all enjoyed a fantastic birthday cake for morning tea on Thursday to celebrate.

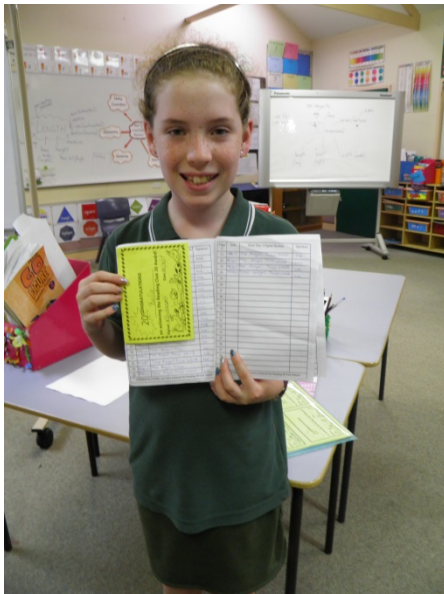


CASSILIS CROSS COUNTRY
