Discus - 5th place

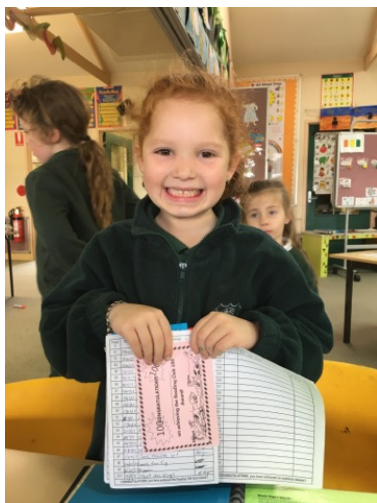
Shot put - 6th place
