#### **3 Rs STUDENT CHOICE AWARDS**

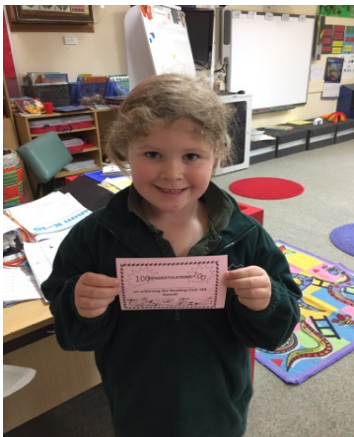
This week's Student Choice Award goes to Emily McGrath, Luke Fay and Tesha Lasham for being helpful and caring towards others.
